## HB64 & SB1775 Fact Sheet

## IL House and Senate Hemp Reform Act

Empowers farmers, supports small businesses, protects public safety, and positions Illinois as a national leader in hemp.

## What's in the bill?

Equitable Access: Removes the Illinois property tax code requirement for hemp licenses, extending access to millions of people who were previously ineligible to grow for food, fiber, soil remediation, or personal care products.

- 2. <u>Public Safety:</u> creates a 21+ age gate for hemp products that contain cannabinoids and minimum guidelines for hemp product safety testing and packaging.

**Federal Alignment:** Aligns Illinois with federal standards; amends the Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to allow hemp as an ingredient; amends the Industrial Hemp Act to require IDOA to update hemp production rules.
